. Participation

- □ Conforming to the FIDE regulations, the African Junior Chess Championship 2022 is open to all players representing federations that are affiliated with the FIDE and the African Chess Confederation.
- ☐ There will be separate championships for the Open and Girls categories.
- ☐ Only players who are born on/or after 1st January 2002 are eligible to participate.
- ☐ The girl's section championship shall be organized if there are at least 10 players from at least 03 Federations. Otherwise, the Girls' event will be merged into the Open Section.
- □ Each Federation is permitted to register one invited player in each category (01 girls
 + 01 open) totaling a maximum of TWO (02) Official Players.
- □ Each Federation will be allowed to enter a maximum of three (01 + 03) more players in each Category (Open and Girls).
- ☐ The host Federation will be allowed to enter five (01 + 05) players in each Category, in case of an odd number, one (01) additional player could be added.
- □ Subject to an agreement with the organizers, the African Chess Confederation president may allow additional participants for the Tournament























II. Registration

- ☐ To guarantee appropriate tournament standards and ultimate organization, all official players and additional (extra) players must submit their registrations through their national federations. Individual applications will not be accepted.
- □ The registration form (Annex A) should be sent to: African_junior2022@yahoo.com and Cc to the president of the Algerian Chess Federation by azdan_2005@yahoo.fr

 After that, automatically a link for online registration (Annex B) will be sent to each federation for individual registration.
- □ The deadline for registration is 15th October 2022 at 00:00 GMT. After this date, a penalty of 100 € (Euros) for each late registration will be charged to participants till 01st November 2022 latest. After that, organizers reserve the right to refuse or decline late registrations or charge double costs for participants.
- □ Federations should make the registration for the official players by the above deadline of 15th October 2022, no official players will be accepted after this date, and their applications will be treated as if they were additional players.
- ☐ Incomplete registration shall not be accepted.


























III. Tournament and ACC Fees

- □ The Official Players, as well as Additional players from each member Federation in each category, will be required to pay an ACC Tournament Fee of 50 € (Euros) each.
- □ Each player (official or additional) and each accompanying person must pay to the organizing committee the amount of 100 € (Euros). This payment includes transportation from and to the airport, accreditation, identification badges, and organization cost.
- ☐ Payments should be made upon arrival. Players whose fees remain unpaid at the start of the Technical Meeting will not be allowed to participate in the tournament.

IV. Hotel Accommodation - Playing Hall

- □ The organizers offer full board accommodation in the RAYA Hotel ★★★★ Tichy city booked by the organizing committee. Free WiFi connection, free indoor swimming pool, and free Hammam for all participants are arranged.


















V. Hotel Accommodation - Playing Hall

- □ Every participant accepted as an additional player and all accompanying persons have to make their registration and bookings through the Organizing Committee by their national federations.
- ☐ All Participants are obliged to stay in the official hotel and bookings must be done through the organizers only. The playing venue will be in the same hotel
- ☐ Lodging for additional players and accompanying persons will cost as follows:

VI. Technical Regulations

- □ Swiss System → 09 rounds: In accordance with FIDE regulations, the tournament will be played according to the Swiss System in 09 rounds.
- □ Time control → 90'/40 moves + 30'+ 30"/move: Time control is 90 minutes for the first 40 moves, followed by 30 minutes for the rest of the game, with an increment of 30 seconds per move starting from the 1st move.
- □ No draw offers are allowed before black's 30 moves, without the consent of the arbiter. All other regulations apply as per FIDE Handbook, including 30 minutes default time for all the rounds.
- ☐ Players from the same Federation will not be paired together in the last round
- ☐ **Tie-breaks:** If two or more players are tied, the following tiebreaks will be used:
 - A) Results of direct encounters between the tied players.
 - B) Buchholz Cut 1.
 - C) Buchholz.
 - **D)** The greater number of games played with black.
 - E) The Greater number of wins (forfeits counted).






























IX. Appeals and Appeals Committee

- □ Complaints judgments of the Chief Arbiter or his assistants must be submitted in written form to the Chairman of the appeals committee within **30 minutes** after the achievement of the respective game.
- ☐ The player may appeal even after signing the scoresheet.
- □ The protest must be accompanied by the sum of 100 € (Euros) as a deposit from the signatory. The deposit must be handed to the Chairman of the appeals committee.
- ☐ If the appeal is approved, the sum shall be returned immediately. If the appeal is refused, the deposit is forfeited to the Algerian Chess Federation.
- ☐ The Appeals Committee will consist of 03 members and 02 reserves.
- ☐ The Chairman of the Appeals Committee will be nominated by the ACC President while the other 02 members and 02 reserves will be selected between the participating federation officials.

X. Arbitration Team

- ☐ The Chief Arbiter, will be designated by the African Chess Confederation President.
- □ Other members of the Arbitration Team will be appointed by ACC President in consultation with the Algerian Chess Federation President.

























XI. Airport/Hotel transfer

☐ The organizers will guarantee a welcome team for all the participants and accompanying persons at the international Houari Boumediene Airport Algiers, all the delegations are requested to provide the full itinerary for each participant and their accompanying persons to the organizer in advance by filling an online form which the link will be sent automatically to all the participant federations.

XII. Visas

- ☐ The entry visa to Algeria is required in many countries and can be obtained from the Algerian Embassies or Consulate Offices in respective countries.
- ☐ The Algerian Chess Federation will provide official invitation letters to the delegations who need a visa entry.
- ☐ The invitations will be sent to the national federations only if they filled up the online visa request form made for that (the link will be sent automatically after confirmation of participation)
- ☐ Please make sure to upload all documents requested for a visa invitation.


























XIII. Local currency and exchange


